**St. Jude Parish Finance Council Minutes  
March 13, 2007**

Meeting opened with a prayer and roll call was made.

Minutes from the February meeting were read and were approved as written.

The agenda for the meeting was approved with no changes.

A lease is close to being finalized with Providence Academy. They will rent out approximately half of the school building for \$1500 per month under a two-year lease. They will also pay approximately \$520 per month toward utilities. The Finance Council approved entering into this lease.

In light of the above lease, Fr. Don intends to move the parish offices into the other half of the school building. This move will save on utilities and we will then try to find a tenant to rent the entire office building. This move was approved by the Finance Council.

The progress of the Advancing the Mission Campaign was briefly discussed.

After some discussions, a break-even budget for 2007/2008 was approved.

Financial Reports for the month of February were reviewed and approved for St. Jude Parish, Trinity School and Religious Education after some discussions and clarifications.

There were no Buildings and Grounds minutes to be reviewed since they did not meet.

The next Finance Council meeting will be Tuesday, April 10, 2007.
