

St. Jude Pastoral Council Meeting
Minutes 3-13-07

Minutes: Correction of notes from #3-replacing the windows. Should be \$300,000, not \$100,000.

Correction - other staffing – a deacon and a 1/3 musician minister for each church.

400 hits on the website in one week.

Correction: Faith Formation vs Education Commission Report – great turn out, 50 attendees for the Valentine party.

Faith Formation will attend Religious Ed classes March 28.

Schoolboard: Should come up with the process and, through the process, come up with three names that will go to the bishop. The bishop will pick the name. Some concerns with a new name: losing more families, cost of change, etc.

Social Concerns: Rheda absent.

Stewardship Commission Report: Letters going out to parishioners. Trinity Athletic Club now named St. Jude Booster Club, will be under the Community Life Commission, social/non-spiritual groups.

Worship Commission Report: Chrism Mass, three parishes involved and the Hmong will be involved in Holy Thursday Mass at St. Jude. Holy Week is being planned and going well. Worship will work on the 50th anniversary celebration date and ideas for the celebration.

New Business:

Meetings: The four parish councils will meet together; one half hour early for one group and father and one half hour later for one group and father. Father will be able to spread news in one meeting rather than separate meetings. Will discuss at the quad-parish meeting.

Old Business:

School Lease: One step away from signing. Lease will begin July 1, 2007. Providence Academy, a nondenominational school, will lease the 1st eight rooms on the Westside of the building (K-8). Two year lease at \$18,000 per year rent and \$6-7,000 per year for utilities. St. Jude may look to lease the parish office building and move the parish offices into the other part of the school building.

Transition Committee: Six members on the committee, one from each of the four parishes with two extra from St. Patrick. Preliminary plan was put together. Transition report is done. Father will send the report to each parish council member.
