1. No roofing bids were received today. Wayne and Carol will contact the three bidders and tell them the bids need to be in one week. When the bids come in, Dave will make PDF copies of the proposals and send them out to all members for review and comments.
2. Rick has a proposal for precast concrete steps outside the sacristy. Cost for steps and railing is \$950. Wayne has not received proposal for the foundation work. Wayne will contact bidder to give a week to provide a proposal. Carol will also see if there are others to get a quote from.
3. A double faced front sign board was brought up to the parish council to look into. Is a double faced sign board needed or will a single face be acceptable? The front of church is not on a well traveled street so do we even need a sign board? With everything being posted on the internet, are sign boards necessary? We will add this to the wish list of things to consider in the future.
4. Have not heard anything on the status of the canopies over the east and west doors to the church from Jones sign. Dave will contact Gary to see if he has heard anything.
5. The leaking windows in the church basement Wayne indicated is coming from the church windows above. It will be very difficult to caulk around the divider strips and the plastic. This will be looked at after the meeting.
6. The old parish center windows need to receive new glazing compound and paint. This work to be looked at being done after the picnic. Carol will see about putting out a request for volunteers to do the work. The inside wood sash could be removed and put in the garage to have the new glazing compound installed and repainted. The sash could be reinstalled in the opening and the storms removed and the outside of the windows repainted.
7. Installing the storage room in the front entrance to the church by the confessionals will be worked on later this fall.

8. The two pine trees at the north side of church should be removed as they are affecting the roof and the pine needles are falling into the air conditioning. When the trees are removed the stumps could be ground out and new smaller shrubs be added back in the area.
9. Before the picnic starts, the construction trucks and trailers should be moved to the west end of the property. Wayne will talk to the workers about this.
